

Let me clarify the sequence of steps to get admitted to Macomb Community College:

- Go to Macomb.edu and click on “get started”
- Scroll down and “Apply for Academic Study.”
- Create your admission account and when finished, it rolls you into the application
- Apply as a Dual Enrollment student. When finished, you’ll receive an email thanking you for applying.
- Wait 2-3 days for your application to be processed...
- You’ll receive an email asking you to log back in with your ADMISSIONS account email and complete 3 steps.
- Click through the New Student Orientation
- Complete the Guided Self Placement in English Language Arts
- Complete the Guided Self Placement in Math
- Call (586) 445-7999, option 2 for your Starting at Macomb session. If you call on Wednesday, that’s walk-in day...you might get an appointment right then. If not, you can schedule a call.
- 4 hours after the SAM session is completed, you will get an email from tech support with your new Macomb email address and TEMPORARY password. You won’t need your admissions account again!
- Log in to My Macomb, using your NEW Macomb email address and temporary password. Change the temporary password immediately (you only get ONE login) and set up Multi-Factor Authorization.
- Now, you can go to My Macomb, plan your classes, and when ready, accept terms and register!
